PROCEDURES FOR VOTER TO FOLLOW:

1. In front of the election official, complete and sign this Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation.
2. Vote your provisional ballot in secret.
3. After voting, put ballot into secrecy sleeve and put secrecy sleeve into provisional ballot envelope.
4. Seal the provisional ballot envelope.
5. Give the Certificate to the Election Official to witness and obtain your Notice for Provisional Ballot Voter.
6. Election Official will place your Provisional Ballot Envelope in the appropriate bag to return it to the Election Office for processing.

5. **ATTENTION:** If you voted this ballot because we could not verify your Florida driver's license number, Florida state identification number, or the last four digits of your social security card number, bring your card in person or provide a copy via mail, fax, or email to the Supervisor of Elections no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 2nd day following the election. If you voted this ballot solely because you did not have the proper photo and signature identification, you do not have to provide any further evidence. Your ballot will be counted if your signature on the ballot certificate matches the signature on your registration record and if you voted in the proper precinct.

IMPORTANT: If this is a Primary Election, you should contact the Supervisor of Elections office immediately to confirm that you are registered and can vote in the General Election.

PROVISIONAL BALLOT PROCESSING PROCEDURES

PROCEDURES FOR ELECTION OFFICIAL TO FOLLOW:

1. Have the voter complete the Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation on reverse side.
2. Witness the voter's signature and complete the "Election Official" section of the Certificate.
3. Issue the voter a ballot, secrecy sleeve, and this certificate envelope.
4. Direct voter to mark ballot, place in secrecy sleeve, and seal in this envelope.
5. Issue the Notice for Provisional Ballot Voter to the voter.
6. Check reason(s) for issuance of Provisional Ballot in boxes below.
7. Place the sealed Provisional Ballot envelope in the appropriate catch all bag.

REASON FOR PROVISIONAL BALLOT (Check all that apply)

- Voter did not provide picture/signature identification.
- Voter's name does not appear on the precinct register and voter's eligibility cannot be verified.
- Voter refutes supervisor's office confirmation that he or she is not registered/eligible.
- Indication on precinct register that voter has returned a mail ballot or has voted in the office or voted at an early voting site, but voter maintains that he or she has not voted, even after a call to the office.
- Indication on precinct register that the voter has been challenged in this election.
- Voter is challenged at precinct (attach copy of challenge – do not enclose oath in envelope).
- Voter's ID signature and signature given do not match. Voter refused affidavit.
- Indication on precinct register that voter's status is pending because FL DL, FL ID card, or SSN has not yet been verified by the state.

PROCEDURES FOR CANVASSING BOARD TO FOLLOW:

1. Review information provided in the Voter's Certificate and Affirmation.
2. Determine if voter is registered in FVRS.
3. Determine if voter voted in the correct precinct.
4. Match voter's signature with signature on file.
5. Determine whether voter cast a Vote By Mail ballot or voted during early voting.
6. Review all information provided by supervisor's office, evidence provided by voter, if any, and any evidence provided by challenger, if applicable.
7. Accept or reject provisional ballot based on preponderance of the evidence.
